

New feature in the FIT Count app: link to a project



When you add a FIT Count survey using the app, there is a new page at the end of the survey details, which asks if you count is linked to a 'project'.

For most people the count will not be linked to a project, in which case all you need to do is to go straight to the bottom of the page and tap on "SAVE MY COUNT"

However, if your count is being done as part of a project, and the project is listed on the page you can choose to link your count to that project. (You will need to scroll down the page to see all the available projects.)

Editing your FIT Counts

If you need to edit one of your counts, e.g. because it is linked to the wrong project, you can do so from the PoMS website. Log on to the website*, and then go to the "View results" menu and choose "My results".

The counts you have added will be listed there, and for each count there is an edit button on the right-hand side of the row:



* If you registered on the app, you will also need to register on the website; ensure that you use the same email address to register in both places, so that your counts get linked up correctly.
